Prepare your tree for recycling by removing all ornaments, garlands, lights, tinsel, plastic bags, or any other artificial materials. Live trees are taken to the Alpha Ridge Landfill to be recycled into compost and mulch. You can recycle your your normal recycling day through January

tree on your normal recycling day through January 15. Trees will not be collected on trash days.

SNOW CLEAN-UP

Don't forget to clear your sidewalk after a snowstorm—it's the law.

"It is the duty and obligation of the owner of property abutting a sidewalk in a public right of way to remove snow from the sidewalk within 48 hours after the snow has fallen." Howard County code, Section 18.402(h).

Do not park on streets, especially on or around cul-de-sacs.



Make snow removal easy for highway crews: park your vehicles in driveways. This also allows police and firefighters to respond quickly to public safety tasks.
