VIOLETS IN YOUR YARD?**



These beautiful little flowers have gotten a bum rap as "weeds" because they spread and reseed easily, but violets are native plants and they are essential to a healthy ecosystem.

Violets support pollinators and bees which, in turn, support other plants and animals. The larva of thirty species of fritillary butterflies depend on violets for food! Besides sustaining butterflies and bees, violets provide good groundcover in shaded or semi-shaded areas. Plant them around trees and under shrubs. Should they begin stray into unwanted areas, wet the ground and pull them while they are young.

Enjoy your violets and the butterflies and bees that depend on them!
