A MESSAGE FROM KC CARES KC VILLAGE ENVIRONMENTAL GROUP SUPPORT MIGRATING MONARCHS



This summer, the monarch declared butterfly was endangered, as populations plummeted due have and climate habitat loss change. The monarchs' fall

migration is beginning, and each of us can help them survive the long journey to Mexico. Monarchs need nectar and safe rest stops all along the migration route. If you've planted native milkweeds, you may already be hosting monarch caterpillars. If you haven't, you can still support the migration by adding an array of fallblooming native plants to your garden. Aromatic asters like "Raydon's Favorite" and goldenrods like "Fireworks" are two beautiful and deer-resistant options. Monarchs also need trees to rest in overnight and for shelter during storms; consider planting more native trees in your yard. Each of our gardens can become a safe and nourishing rest stop for monarch butterflies.

KC CARES RECYCLING TIPS

 Japanese stiltgrass is a pervasive shallow-rooted invasive in our area. It is easily removed and should be because it prevents plants from going to seed.



Stiltgrass should go straight into your **trash** — not yard waste; it can go into compost as long as there are no seed heads.

♦ Grasscycling, or letting grass clippings decompose on the lawn after mowing, encourages a healthier lawn by returning macro and micronutrients to the soil. The environment benefits by an up to 25% reduction in fertilizer decreasing the amount of runoff into the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries.

CA BUDGET PROCESS

CA Welcome to the Association Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 budget process, a chance for you to provide feedback on CA's priorities and investments. CA's FY2024 begins May 1, 2023 and ends April 30, 2024.

The Board is scheduled to start discussing (via Zoom) the FY2024 budget during its regularly scheduled work session on September 8 @ 7pm. The Board is set to narrow down top priorities and vote on those at the meeting on September 22 @ 7pm. Residents are always welcome to participate in Resident Speakout, which happens at the start of every Board meeting and work session. These meetings are also live streamed and recorded on YouTube. In addition to Board meetings, you will also have a chance to offer your input online from October 27-November 3.

Anyone looking to affect change in the budget should get involved in the early part of the process and let the Board know what your priorities are for CA.
