Avoid having animals tear open trash bags and scatter garbage. Please use solid trash cans with lids or wait until the morning of pick-up to put out securely tied trash bags. Remember to bring your cans back in the same day after trash and recycle are picked up. Cans should be stored in your garage or behind your house.

A MESSAGE FROM KC CARES KC VILLAGE ENVIRONMENTAL GROUP SAFE MOSQUITO CONTROL



If mosquitos are making your yard unpleasant, you may wonder if spraying your property is safe and effective. Unfortunately, it is neither. Even the "all-natural"

chemicals touted by companies can sicken you, your kids, your neighbors, and your pets. They also kill bumblebees, fireflies, and the birds that eat mosquitos. Rain washes the chemicals into our streams where they poison aquatic life. Instead, you can easily set up a "mosquito trap" that kills mosquito larvae – it is safe, effective, and it's as simple as a bucket, a mosquito "dunk", and a handful of straw. 
