A MESSAGE FROM KC CARES KC VILLAGE ENVIRONMENTAL GROUP Pondering Ponds

Dreaming about improvements to this year's garden? A pond the size of a cooking pot can help support wildlife: frogs, snails, salamanders, songbirds, and more. Even the smallest pond can provide shelter, drinking water, and a place to raise young. Plan your own now with flexible rubber or pre-formed plastic liners, and populate it this spring with plants native to our area (ask KCCARES about local residents happy to share plants). Once you include shallow margins or sticks that provide a way to climb in and out,

your pond may be inhabited by grateful creatures in just a few days! Don't forget to drop in a mosquito dunk once a month; these dunks use naturally occurring bacteria to kill mosquito larvae, making your pond double as a mosquito trap.

- Check out your preparer. Make sure your preparer is properly licensed by going to DLLR's website: DLLR.State.MD.US/PQ/
- 3. **Avoid refund anticipation loans**. Fees and interest will be deducted from your refund.
- 4. **Stay alert for IRS imposters**. The IRS does not call taxpayers who owe back taxes. Hang up if the caller asks for immediate payment.


