#### A MESSAGE FROM KC CARES KC VILLAGE ENVIRONMENTAL GROUP The Ecosystem and Your Lawn



Lawns are great for playtime with kids and picnics for families, but modern American lawn care contributes climate to and change ecosystem degradation. Gas-powered

lawn equipment has inefficient engines that pollute our air, while fertilizers and herbicides end up mostly washing into our streams and lakes. Excess nitrogen from our lawn services causes the annual green algal slime on Columbia's lakes, at huge cost to all of us.

You can keep making happy memories on your lawn, while also adding value to our ecosystem. Start by deciding how much lawn you actually need for recreation; reduce the footprint of your lawn by replacing unused corners or edges with native garden beds. On the lawn you keep, use electric lawn care equipment – or hire a crew that uses electric equipment – and instead of chemical fertilizers, mow your fall leaves into the grass, returning nutrients to the soil. These simple practices help keep our air clean and our streams healthy.
