Come learn how to grow Maryland spring flowers, why they are so special, and about our native pollinators that depend on them.



## SLIDE SCHEDULE: TRASH & RECYCLING

Both Christmas and New Year's weeks are on a "slide" schedule. All trash, recycling and yard trim collections scheduled those weeks will "slide" and be made one day later that week.

### A MESSAGE FROM KC CARES KC VILLAGE ENVIRONMENTAL GROUP Birds Need Our Help!



As colder weather returns, birds must greatly increase their calorie intake to keep warm and survive. They need seeds, nuts, and berries from native plants-as well as insects from leaf litter

--but natural habitats where these are found are rapidly shrinking due to invasion of non-native plants and development.

Help birds survive the winter by putting up and maintaining bird feeders. If possible, put up multiple feeders with different seeds to attract different species and limit waste. Clean feeders regularly to stop bacteria and mold growth and prevent disease. Cleaning up seed hulls below the feeder will also help prevent disease and discourage rodents.

Next spring, plant more natives in your yard and leave the leaf litter and native plant seed heads when they die back, so birds can benefit from their natural food sources. Enjoy the beauty and antics of our avian neighbors and help them endure the winter weather!

#### **No Curbside Pickup for** Lithium-Ion Batteries

Lithium-Ion batteries and any device that contains a lithium-ion battery should NEVER be placed out for curbside trash or recycling collection. These batteries and devices are considered hazardous and have contributed to fires at the County's Alpha Ridge Landfill and inside the curbside collection trucks. Help keep workers safe by correctly and properly disposing of your lithium-ion batteries and devices containing them. Take them to a retail take-back program at Lowe's, Home Depot, Staples or Ikea, or drop them at Alpha Ridge during Hazardous Household Waste collection days (Saturdays from April –November.)
